

LPRRA Covid 19 Tennis Requirements

Covid 19 Fundamental Requirements

1. Maintain distance of 2 metres from all individuals other than those from your household
2. Wash/sterilize your hands often
3. Keep hands away from your face

Specific LPRRA Tennis Requirements

**Note that currently, Pickle ball is not permitted as maintaining the 2 metres on the smaller court and avoiding body contact with the ball would be very difficult.

1. Review Tennis Canada "Tips and Recommendations for Players" located on bulletin board and in Long Point website.
2. Each player assumes responsibility for their safety and the safety of the players in their game, with regards to Covid 19 Fundamental Requirements above. The LPRRA will not be responsible for the safety of those individuals that choose to play.
3. Play only with family members, persons living in your household or individuals considered to be low risk.
4. Do not play if you exhibit any coronavirus symptoms.
5. Wash/sterilize your hands prior to entering tennis courts, after exiting and after contacting any common touch points e.g. gate, reservation tags
6. Each person or household must have their own tennis balls clearly marked with their initials. Server will use their tennis balls only and others will pass the ball to the server with their racquet only. There should never be hand contact with any tennis ball other than your own.

**Note Hand sanitizer will not be provided at court location nor will anyone in the Association be sanitizing any parts of the court or associated hardware. It is expected that individuals using the courts will be responsible for their own safety including sterilizing and sanitizing as necessary.

Tennis Court Reservation Process

1. Graham purchased new plastic gold tags for everyone. These are the only tags to be used. If you have not received yours, please contact George Aunger 416-574-1168 to purchase one. If you have lost yours, I can provide you with a temporary tag while the new one is being made. I have placed available ones on the board.
2. If you are clearing the board at 8pm, be sure to bring a pen with you to document your name and time. Remember to sanitize your hands right after.
